

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING, SLEEPY HOLLOW CORPORATE AUTHORITIES  
JULY 13, 1976

A special meeting of the Sleepy Hollow Corporate Authorities was called to order by the President, Mrs. Schoengart, at 7:10 p.m. on Tuesday, July 13, 1976 in the Village hall. The meeting was requested by Mrs. Schoengart and notice duly delivered to the Trustees on Sunday, July 11, 1976, as required by law.

Roll call was taken and answered as follows: Ciuca, absent; Higgons, Krueger, Male, Morency, Roberts, Schoengart, present.

Also present was Tom Lapins, manager of the Sleepy Hollow Water Corporation.

The meeting agenda consisted of considering a sprinkling ban because of pressure shortage in the village water system and was called because of citizen complaints of lack of pressure and because Mr. Lapins requested that the Board consider a sprinkling ban so that the water company could supply sufficient pressure to all the Village.


Mr. Lapins explained that the booster pumps on Beau Brummel Drive keep kicking out because of the high demand being made on them and that those pumps have been repaired, but that in order to keep them working properly less demand must be made on them.

The clerk read Ordinance Number 12-2-1, being, "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SPRINKLING OF LAWNS OR SHRUBBERY OR GARDENS WITH WATER DISTRIBUTED BY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM IN THE VILLAGE OF SLEEPY HOLLOW, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS."

Mrs. Male moved that Ordinance 12-2-1 be adopted by the Sleepy Hollow Board of Trustees. Mr. Krueger seconded. Roll call was taken and answered as follows: Higgons, Krueger, Male, Morency, Roberts, aye; 0 nays; 1 absent; motion carried.

Mr. Roberts moved that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Morency seconded.
