MINUTES, VILLAGE BOARD MEETING, SEPTEMBER 17, 1979

The regular meeting of the Sleepy Hollow Corporate Authorities was called to order on September 17, 1979 at 7:35 PM by President Carol Schoengart. Roll was called and answered as follows: Milz, Mountjoy, Peterson, Roberts, Thomas, Zhe, present. Also present were Clerk Pofahl, Treasurer Scott, Chief Bradley, Engineer Andersen, Plan Commission Hohner. Mrs. Peterson moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting, second by Mr. Mountjoy, motion carried by voice vote.

Treasurer's report--Cash receipts: \$9,221.07; Bills payable, \$4,973.57. Cash balances: General, \$81,449.15; Building, \$31,886.29; MFT, \$36,776.75; Revenue Sharing, \$3,944.86; Total: 163,511.43. Mr. Roberts moved to accept the Treasurer's report and pay the bills second by Mr. Thomas, roll call: Milz, Mountjoy, Peterson, Roberts, Thomas, Zhe, aye; 0 nays, 0 absent.

The road program is finished for this year, approximate cost \$33,500.
