Village Board Minutes, September 15, 1980

The regular meeting of the Sleepy Hollow Corporate Authorities was called to order by President Schoengrt on September 15, 1980 at 7:35 PM. Roll was called and asswered as follows: Milz, Montjoy, Peterson, Robrts Thomas, Schoengart, present, Zhe absent; also present were Cark Pofahl, Treasner-Scott, Chief Bradky, Attarney Knickebocker, Plan Commission Chairman Harlovic.

Mrs. Peterson moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting, second by Mountjoy, motion carried by voice vote.

Treasurer's report: Bills payable, \$4,644.84 plus Real Estate Taxes \$725.58 =Total, \$5,370.42. Fund balances, General \$49,856.75; Building, \$46,147.24; MFT,\$38,135.52; Revenue Sharing, \$3,442.30; Road Bond, \$6,452.41; Total, \$144,034.22. Receipts, \$546.23.

Mr. Milz moved to accept the Treasurer's report and pay the bills, second by Peterson, roll call: Milz, Mountjoy, Peterson, Roberts, Thomas, aye. l absent.

Mr. Harlovic reported on the meetings with Gilberts. Land uses were agreed upon, but not jurisdictional boundarjes.

Mr. Roberts moved to allow a one day liquor license for the Sleepy Hollow PTC Speghetti Dinner on October 22, second by Mountjoy, roll call: Milz, Mountjoy, Peterson, Roberts, homas, aye, 1 absent.

Mr. Milz moved to make a firm offer to the Village of Algonquin to purchase for \$1,000 the generator and truck, second by Peterson, roll call: Milz, Mountjoy, Peterson, Roberts, Thomas aye; 1 absent.

The ZBA minutes of August 23, 1980 were read, plans and photos were presented by Mr. and Mrs. Thietje concerning their fence. Mrs. Peterson moved to accept the ZBA recommendation and allow the construction of the fence around the property within the setback lines, second by Mountjoy, motion carried by voice vote, an ordinance will be prepared and presented at the next regular Board Meeting.

Mr. Milz discussed the electrical work to be done in the garage. Mr. Roberts moved to rescind the prior motion authorizing \$5,000 bid for the work, second by Mountjoy; Mr. Mountjoy withrew his second, the motion died.

Mr. Milz, moved to allow a one day liquor license for the Sleepy Hollow Service Club Sptemberfest on Sept. 27 at the Fire Station, second by Mountjoy, roll call: Milz, Mountjoy, Peterson, Roberts, Thomas, aye. 1 absent.

Mr. Milz moved to accept the low bid of \$2,620 for the concrete slab for salt and sand of Quindel Construction. Co., 18 S. Aldine, Elgin, second by Mountjoy, roll call: Milz, Mountjoy, Peterson, Roberts, Thomas, aye; 1 absent.

Mr. Baresel will bury the gas tank and break up the concrete next to the Village hall at a cost of \$45 per hour. Road gravel will be put in the parking lot.

Mr. Mountjoy moved to accept the low price of \$1,915 from Swensen for a single auger salt spreader, second by Roberts, roll call: Milz, Mountjoy, Roberts, Peterson, Thomas, aye. l absent.

The attorney requested an executive session to discuss acquisition of property.
