Village Board Minutes April 4, 1983

The regular meeting of the Sleepy Hollow Copporate Authorities was called to order on April 4, 1983 by President Peterson at 7:40 PM. Roll call: Matthews, Roberts, Treece, Petrerson, present. Mr. Treece moved to accept the corrected minutes, second by Roberts, carried by voice.

The suit against the County Assessor, Treasurer and Village is scheduled to be heard on April 20, 9:00 AM. Mr. Roberts moved to authorize the attorney to represent the Village on April 20, second by Matthews, roll call: Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Treece, aye.

Bob Hale of the Sleepy Hollow Service Club asked permission to enclose a portion of the pavillion. Plans were presented. Mrs. Matthews moved to grant permission to go ahead with the project, second by Rabe, carried by voice.

Mr. Tester, manager of Penny's Store in the Mall appologised for not inviting the Village Board members to the grand opening of the store and invited anyone to come for a tour.

Engineer: Brian will investigate a "waste disposal zone" as a special service area which gives the Village the right to maintain pipes on private property. The restricted weight ord. on the roads should ramain in effect for another two weeks.

Mr. Rabe moved to hire Terry Wessels' father-in-law to work 35 hours a week at \$5.50 per hour for roads, water, parks, Village Hall, second by Roberts, carried by voice.
