Village Board Minutes, January 3, 1984

The regular meeting of the Sleepy Hollow Corporate Authorities was called to order by President Peterson on January 3, 1984 at 7:35 PM at the Fire Station. Roll call: Cook, Matthews, Treece, Peterson, also Pofahl, Panning, Chief Bradley, Attorney Knickerbocker.
