## <u>VILLAGE OF SLEEPY HOLLOW</u> Meeting -- August 27, 1959

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 P.M. on August 27, 1959. First order of business was the roll call which answered as follows:

Malcolm McCuaig Village Attorney, presented an ordinance hereafter to be known as Ordinance 59-5, this being an ordinance for the levy and assessment of taxes for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1959 and ending April 30, 1960; of the Village of Sleepy Hollow, Kane County, Illinois. Ordinance 59-2 was read to the Village Board for approval by Mr. McCuaig. The motion to accept Ordinance 59-2 as presented was made by Elmer Houlberg and seconded by Alfred Falese. A roll call vote was made as follows:

Floyd Falese next reported to at Sleepy Hollow Road has been shaped and graded by Mr. Bonkoski. Mr. Bonkoski has agreed to absorb 50% of the blacktopping cost to complete the finish on Sleepy Hollow Road. He has further agreed to extend the billing until the Village has road money available.

Eugene Unterschuetz next made the motion that the chairman of the road committee contract with the Dundee Township road commission for the paving of Sleepy Hollow Road. The total amount of the contract may be up to but shall not exceed \$500.00. This motion was seconded by Alfred Falese and a roll call vote was made as follows:
